THE COMPANY

Led by Founder and Artistic Director Igal Perry, Peridance Contemporary Dance Company (PCDC) has been a powerhouse of expression and innovation since 1983. As a repertory company, PCDC is committed to amplifying diverse artistic voices from a range of established and emerging choreographers. This philosophy, paired with virtuosic and dynamic performers, has made PCDC a premiere contemporary dance company in New York City for 40 years.

Founded in tandem with **Peridance Center**, a dance education hub in Union Square, the Company has performed at Joyce Theater, BAM, Lincoln Center, the KnJ Theater at Peridance, and more. National tours have included Jacob's Pillow, Stonybrook University, and the Butler Arts Center. Internationally, PCDC has represented the United States at the Suzanne Dellal Dance Centre for Dance and Theater in Tel Aviv, Ballet Internacional de Buenos Aires, Kwang-Ju Dance Festival in South Korea, Italy's Maggio Musicale, among others.

PCDC is grounded in its unwavering commitment to collaboration and artistic innovation. In addition to Perry's signature works, described as "blessedly inventive" by The New York Times, PCDC often serves as a launchpad for choreographic careers. The Company has premiered new works by 30 choreographers including world-renowned artists Sidra Bell, Alice Klock, Dwight Rhoden, Yin Yue, johannes weiland, and more. Reflecting Perry's commitment to new or live music and dance, the Company has also engaged over 50 musicians and composers over the past decade.

Public and educational programming are vital to PCDC, with sought-after open workshops, free performances, multidisciplinary university residencies, and our DanceBreak outreach initiative. Since DanceBreak's launch in 2016, company dancers have taught repertory, modern technique, improvisation, and composition to over 2,000 NYC public school students. With an holistic pedagogical approach, PCDC increases access to contemporary dance and cultivates the next generation of dance artists.

IGAL PERRY Artistic Director

World-renowned choreographer, ballet master, and dance educator, Igal Perry, is the founder and Artistic Director of Peridance Contemporary Dance Company and Peridance Center. With choreography known for its attuned musicality, kinetic inventiveness, and emotional depth, Perry leads with thoughtful patience and bold authenticity.

Perry has created work for countless prestigious companies worldwide. Commissions have included Batsheva, Bat-Dor Dance Companies, the Karmiel Dance Festival (Israel), Ailey II, Complexions Contemporary Ballet (NYC), Companhia de Dança de Lisboa (Portugal), and Alberta Ballet (Canada).

Born in Israel, Perry began his dancing career with folk-dance company, Karmon. He later joined Bat-Dor Dance Company, where he worked with leading teachers and choreographers including Alvin Ailey, Benjamin Harkarvy, John Butler, Rudi Van Dantzig, Inesse Alexandrov, Paul Sanasardo, and Lar Lubovitch. Upon arriving in the United States, Perry joined Dennis Wayne's Dancers as ballet master and choreographer, and staged John Butler's work for the NYC Opera, the Opera of Munich, Caracas Ballet, and Teatro Alla Scala in Milan.

After heading the ballet department at Jacob's Pillow, he launched the Peridance Center, now one of New York City's leading dance institutions, and founded Peridance Contemporary Dance Company, for which he has choreographed over 60 works.

Perry's influential teaching has led him beyond Peridance Center to The Jacob's Pillow Festival, The Ailey School, and Marymount Manhattan College, Juilliard, Scapino Ballet and Het National Ballet (Holland), Laterna Magica and the National Ballet (Prague), Architanz (Tokyo), The Royal Ballet of Sweden and Balettakademien (Sweden), the National Ballet of China, and the Kwang-Ju City Ballet Company (Korea).

TECHNICAL REQUIREMNETS

Level stage floor, preferably sprung. No concrete.

Marley dance floor covering entire stage surface.

Minimum surface dimensions of 36 feet wide by 28 feet deep.

House sound system with computer tie-in for audio playback, sufficient speaker amplification to cover entire auditorium..

OUTREACH AND EDUCATION

MASTER CLASSES | 45 min - 2 hr

Taught by either Igal Perry or Company Dancers, Master Classes offer students a unique opportunity to learn from PCDC's wide-ranging repertoire in ballet or contemporary techniques.

LEC-DEM | 45 min - 2 hr

Ideal for large groups of students, Lecture-Demonstrations combine the benefits of live performance and a Q&A. Participants watch PCDC dancers perform excerpts of select works, reflect on their themes, and engage in direct conversation with the dancers about the process of creation and artistic analysis.

CHOREOGRAPHIC COLLABORATION | 2 weeks

Perfect for collegiate or advanced students, PCDC company members work alongside the students to collaborate with a choreographer and create a new work. This process grants students a unique opportunity to partner with and be inspired by professional company members during a creation process.

REPERTORY SETTING | 1 - 2 weeks

Company members reset a work by Igal Perry on the students, passing on valuable information from his legacy.
